- Equipment/Repairs & Maintenance: All equipment has been stored for the winter.
- 2017 Tractor Leases: 2 tractors will be available for lease this spring. Rick Kerr will check with other implement dealers to try to find one more lease tractor.
- 2017 Trees/Fabric: Currently have 18.8 acres of tree plantings and 52,640 LF Tree Fabric (10 miles). Jon is currently working on several acres of tree plans. Jon reported fabric has been ordered.
- Building: Jerry and Jon have been checking in at the District building. Heat and water lines are ok.
- Eastern Red cedar Replacements: Towner Nursery will replace, at no cost, 1,450 Eastern Red Cedar planted last spring.
